We will immerse ourselves in the context of Thailand, learning more about its social, environmental and political context as inspiration to construct our own social impact projects. The 2 days will include:

- Local Guest speakers who can educate us on global challenges, social impact and sustainability, as well as how organizations are successfully tackling these challenges
- Engaging in transformative dialogue around sustainability and community issues that need our attention, compassion and solutions. We begin with **CONVERSATION**.
- While sustainability challenges are global, they all have their roots in the mindset and actions of local communities. We don't need to solve everything - we begin at home. We will use the context of our Thai venue to understand more deeply the specific challenges they face and what community action is being taken to make an impact. This will be educational, inspiring and thought provoking

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Visa and Travel Information

Located in Asia, Thailand receives international flights from around the world each day. The country has six international airports, and the closest one to the World Game 2024 venue is the Phuket International Airport. Some other methods of transportation that can be used to reach Thailand are the ferry from Kuala Lumpur or the train.

If you are arriving by air, depending on where you are traveling from, you will either have a direct flight or a connecting flight. One of the most popular routes is to fly into the country's capital, Bangkok and take a domestic connecting flight from there. Alternatively, you can book a direct flight into Phuket International Airport.





Tickets for international travel will rise, so we recommend booking yours well in advance!

Many nationalities are able to visit Thailand without a visa. Some nationalities do not require one at all and others will be granted a visa upon entry. Check which option applies to you here and pay special attention to the allowed duration of stay. Whether you need a visa or not, remember that you will need to show proof of where you will be staying as well as a return ticket upon arrival.

"As coaches, we ponder how we can envision life-altering outcomes that assist everyone in **tackling the monumental challenges of our contemporary world**," says Marilyn Atkinson.

In her book, "The World Game," Marilyn Atkinson recognizes that games are universal, whether played for amusement, achievement, or diversion; they are an innate aspect of the human psyche. However, Marilyn asserts that we often confine ourselves within self-imposed boundaries, restricting the scope of the lifelong game we already engage in, which encompasses survival, inspiration, and existence. Adding this game to our individual lives may be viewed as a limited endeavor, akin to swimming in a small tank. So, how can we transition from a confined tank to a vast aquarium and elevate the stakes? Marilyn's counsel? "Engage in a grander game."

"The World Game" urges us to partake in purposeful endeavors with societal significance for a positive, lighthearted approach that invites collaboration with fellow participants. **To truly expand one's horizons, it is those audacious enough to want to change the world who often achieve it.** But where do we begin? The World Game first began in London, uniting Erickson partners, facilitators, and coaches from around the globe in a solution-driven gathering aimed at collectively expanding their horizons by co-creating initiatives with tangible impact. Subsequent World Games have taken place in Turkey, Bali and Egypt, focusing on building connections with the aspiration of igniting a ripple effect in human consciousness.
